

The Homeschool Hawks 4-H Club is open to Hart County Homeschooling families. The club meets at the extension office 4pm-5pm.



We will be touring the State Capitol and Liberty Hall Historic Site.



4-H Summer Camp

It is time to start thinking about 4-H summer camp!

Hart County will be attending 4-H Summer Camp July 8th-11th in Dawson Springs, Kentucky at West Kentucky 4-H Camp.

4-H Camp offers water slides, rock climbing walls, zip lines, nature hikes, shooting ranges, horse-back riding, canoeing, kayaking, dancing, crafts and so much more!

Camp is open to Hart County youth ages 9-14. *An 8 year* old may attend if they are entering 4th grade in the fall of 2024.

The office will begin accepting camp applications on **January 11th.** Camp spots will be first come first serve. The deadline to sign up is **May 31st.**

For camp spots to be held a completed application with a \$25 deposit must be turned into the office. Reservations over the phone, via e-mail or with incomplete applications will not be accepted.

Camp price is \$300 per camper. Balance must be paid in full by June 7th.

Applications for 4-H Camp are available online or may be picked up at the office. Scholarships are available.
