

OUTSTANDING COUNTY 4-H HORSEMAN AWARD

An award will be given annually at the Hart County 4-H Achievement Night program to the county 4-H'er who excels in the horse project.

1. A 4-H'er shall be deemed eligible for this award if they have reached their 9th birthday or in the 4th grade as of January 1 of the current year, but has not passed their 19th birthday as of January 1 of the current year.
2. This award will be available only to eligible 4-H'ers enrolled in the Hart County 4-H Program.
3. Each 4-H Club leader will be responsible for events with verification of 4-H'ers participation.
4. The final selection will be based on total number of verified points.
5. A 4-H'er is not eligible to receive the award two consecutive years.
6. Points may only be awarded if the activity was 4-H sponsored.
7. Applications are due to the Hart County Extension Office no later than 4:00 p.m. on the first Friday in September of each year.
8. The 4-H'er must have a minimum of 4 (four) points to be eligible to compete for this award.

One point will be given for each of the following activities that the 4-H'er participates in during the year with the 4-H year beginning September 1 and concluding August 31 (except where noted). A brief narrative describing what the 4-H member has learned from their project will be worth 10 points. In the case of a tie, the award will be based on the total number and color of ribbons received at each of the activities listed in their horse project award form. Ribbons count for the following points: Blue = 3 points; Red = 2 points and White = 1 point.
